OMC's After Hours Drug and Alcohol Program


Providing our business partners with superior access to services has been a priority for Olmsted Medical Center.

OMC once again offers 24/7 coverage for drug and alcohol testing for organizations in the Rochester area. OMC businesses that require a drug and alcohol screening between the hours of 7:01 PM to 6:59 AM and on weekends and holidays can receive services by going to Olmsted Medical Center-Hospital.

Drug screens done afterhours, on weekends, or on holidays will be charged a drug and alcohol testing service fee of \$80.00. This fee will be in addition to the normal cost of the service(s) being performed.
